

SATI is a non-profit that aims to improve healthcare and education for at-risk and underserved children and youth in Thailand.

Our Approach

Our approach combines mindfulness and engagement-focused workshops with data collection to identify individuals who need deeper interventions.

The SATI Foundation leverages data as a crucial tool to address the complex challenges faced by underserved youth. By collecting real-time data through surveys, workshops, and counseling sessions, SATI identifies specific risk factors such as mental health concerns, family instability, and substance abuse. This data-driven approach allows SATI to design targeted interventions that address the unique needs of each child and their community. For example, mental health assessments conducted during group activities help identify individuals at high risk, enabling timely psychological support and counseling. By continuously analyzing this information, SATI ensures that its programs remain adaptive, impactful, and focused on long-term solutions for youth empowerment and well-being.

2024 Year In Review

2024 was a year of growth and impact for SATI. One of the most remarkable developments was the expansion of our team, with more members, volunteers, and supporters joining our mission. This growth not only strengthened our capacity but also allowed us to reach and support more underserved children and youth.

This year, we reached and empowered 1,495 youth, provided workshops in 14 schools, and engaged with 8 communities. While our core work remains focused on fostering soft skills, mental health, and overall well-being, this year also highlighted our ability to respond to urgent physical needs. The devastating floods in Northern Thailand tested our resilience, but through collective efforts and generous donations, we were able to coordinate relief efforts and help rebuild affected schools. This experience reinforced the power of collaboration and adaptability, shaping our path forward as we continue to create lasting change.



SATI Foundation operates across both urban and rural regions of Thailand, with a strong presence in **Bangkok** and the northern provinces of **Chiang Mai** and **Chiang Rai**.

In Bangkok, we engage with at-risk youth from various communities, while in the north, we collaborate with schools to provide essential educational and empowerment programs to underserved youth. We believe that the challenges faced by youth in rural and urban areas are interconnected. Many at-risk youth in Bangkok are former rural children who, due to a lack of opportunities, migrate—or are even deceived—into the city in search of a better life. By addressing the root causes of these challenges, we strive to create a more inclusive and supportive environment for all young people.



SATI Foundation made significant strides in reaching and empowering youth through our diverse programs, engaging 1,495 youth across 14 schools and 8 communities in Thailand. Our initiatives focused on mental health, sexual education, creative expression, and practical skills to promote education, healthcare, and overall well-being



Across the 8 communities based mainly in Bangkok, we delivered workshops and activities designed to foster resilience, creativity, and personal growth.

In the northern region of Thailand, SATI Foundation worked with 11 schools to deliver essential programs focused on life skills, mental health, and drug prevention.

Scholarship Program

This year, SATI supported **23 scholarship students**, ranging from 5 to 21 years old, across various educational settings, including boarding schools, public schools, and universities. Beyond financial aid, the program integrates work-study opportunities, counseling, and a data-driven approach to ensure students receive both academic and emotional support. Through regular check-ins and psychological care, SATI helps students navigate challenges, develop practical skills, and build a sustainable future.

We are always **open to donations** to continue supporting these youth in their educational journey.

Our Supporters

In September, in honor of International Day of Charity, We joined **Ford Philanthropy** for Ford Global Caring Month. In 2024, we collaborated with **3 schools** in **Chonburi** and **Rayong**—Ban Khao Khan Song, Banrawoeng, and Chumchon Borisat Namtan Tawan Ok—reaching **141 students.** With the support of 110 Ford volunteers, we organized workshops on self-exploration and sex education, focusing on the importance of community involvement and giving back.

Rosewood Bangkok, a long-standing partner, has been a vital supporter of our mission to empower youth. This year, 5 Hmong girls participated in workshops that included cooking, drink preparation, embroidery, and garland-making. These hands-on activities offer valuable vocational skills that can help the girls build careers, whether in hospitality or other fields, and are a testament to Rosewood's dedication to nurturing the future of young people.

We are also thankful for the support of Born This Way Foundation and Cotton On Foundation, who share our commitment to mental health and the well-being of young people. Their partnership helped us offer mental health counseling and support to the youth we serve. Additionally, The Skateroom provided us with a grant to support kids at Baan Preduce Skatepark, giving them an opportunity to engage in skateboarding while gaining confidence and exploring new possibilities for their futures.




Success Stories


At SATI, we are always prepared to respond to crises that impact children and youth. In September, devastating floods swept through northern Thailand, severely damaging multiple schools and displacing families. Beyond the destruction of classrooms and infrastructure, many children faced disruptions in their education and emotional distress from losing their homes and schools overnight.

In response, SATI launched an emergency fundraising campaign to support the rebuilding efforts. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we raised 139,397 THB, enabling us to assist 5 schools in Chiang Mai and 4 schools in Chiang Rai with urgent reconstruction. Additionally, in Khun Yuam District, Mae Hong Son, 86 students across 3 schools received new school uniforms, helping them regain a sense of normalcy and dignity.
